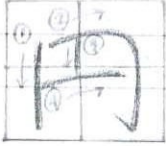

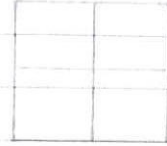
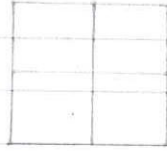
① 円ってなに? (What's "yen"?)

円 (yen) is the unit of money in Japan. The Japanese pronunciation of yen is more like "en".








We use a Chinese character (called "Kanji") to write this.
